

The FINRA Foundation invites nominations for the [Ketchum Prize](#) for outstanding service and research to advance investor protection and financial capability in the United States. The prize consists of national recognition and \$10,000. **Nominations for the 2017 prize must be received by March 1, 2017.**

Eligible nominees must have exemplary research or service achievements related to the prize theme. In awarding the Ketchum Prize, the FINRA Foundation will assign priority to nominees that:

- Made demonstrable improvements to investor protection and/or financial capability in the United States through research, education or public communications
- Addressed the financial wellness needs or circumstances of underserved audiences
- Modeled effective collaboration or partnership-building in the field of financial capability
- Emphasized data analysis and data application in efforts to advance investor protection and financial capability.
