## **Financial Literacy and Education Commission Seeks Public Comments on National Strategy Update**

The Financial Literacy and Education Commission is seeking public comments as it updates the 2011 National Strategy, titled [Promoting Financial Success in the United States](#).

April marks [National Financial Capability Month](#), and it is an important time to think about how more Americans can build stronger financial skills and gain access to safe, affordable financial products and services that can lead to greater financial well-being.

The Update will highlight the state of financial education today and discuss the Commission's accomplishments and next steps, informed by what we have learned about financial literacy and financial well-being in the last several years.

We would like the public's thoughts on whether the proposed outline for the National Strategy Update reflects current research and practice, whether there are other elements that should be included, and any other comments.
